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ADMISSIONS

We know of no other organization in the Pacific Northwest more committed to putting together groups of students who are positive, enthusiastic, eager and considerate. Our enrollment process involves a thorough application review, two reference checks from teachers and/or coaches and a personal student interview for every student.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Upon receipt of your application we will confirm availability. Most of our programs fill in March and April; some programs fill earlier. We are unable to hold a spot without both an application and deposit.

Upon acceptance, you will receive a detailed trip information packet, including: travel information, clothing and equipment list, student contract, medical form, Youth Outdoor Adventures (YOA) general release form and additional release forms from our professional subcontractors. You must sign the appropriate forms and return them to us by the indicated due date in your packet.

PAYMENTS, WITHDRAWALS, REFUNDS

A 50% deposit fee must accompany your application. The balance of your tuition is due no later than the 1st of the month of your adventure. Any balance past due is subject to a 3% late fee. If you withdraw in writing before June 15th you will forfeit \$250 of your deposit. If you withdraw in writing after June 15th there are no refunds for any reason whatsoever (including, but not limited to, voluntary withdrawal, illness or injury prior to or during the program, summer school, security concerns, or any other reason). The 50% deposit is refundable in full if the applicant is denied acceptance due to our admissions criteria.

If you leave an adventure after it starts for any reason whatsoever (including, but not limited to, voluntary withdrawal, disciplinary infractions (see Rules and

Regulations), illness, injury, ailment, security concerns, or any other reason) there are no refunds.

EXPECTATIONS

Our adventures are wholesome, structured experiences with strong leadership and high expectations of our students' behavior. Every YOA student is expected to be positive and motivated with strong leadership and group skills. All students are expected to participate enthusiastically in all of our camps' activities and to shoulder camp responsibilities with a positive attitude.

Ultimately it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to assess the appropriateness of these programs for their daughter/son.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Both parent/guardian and the participant understand that for the health, safety and welfare of all members of YOA, rules and regulations formulated by the staff members of YOA must be strictly observed. YOA has the right to terminate, without refund, the participation of any member who refuses to cooperate. If a participant leaves the group either voluntarily or is sent home by an authorized YOA employee, every effort will be made to contact the parent/guardian or emergency contact of the participant. YOA will not be held responsible for the participant if these persons are absent at the time YOA tries to get in touch with them.

The use or possession of any form of tobacco, any alcoholic product, or an illegal drug will result in the participant's immediate dismissal and return home from the program, without a refund and at the expense of the family.

COMMUNICATION

In an effort to foster a sense of independence and self-reliance, we do not permit phone calls to or from our students during camp.

Please note that during camp, YOA staff is available 7 days a week. You will be able to speak to a live person 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The ranch phone is 541-333-0833. If an important situation arises and a student needs to speak with his or her parents, we can make certain that this connection occurs in a timely fashion.

PERSONAL ELECTRONICS

In an effort to eliminate distractions among the group and to promote engagement in all activities, personal electronic devices, such as iPods, handheld gaming devices and cell phones are not allowed during any of our programs. YOA cannot be held responsible for any electronic devices, which are lost or stolen.

HEALTH REPORT

If we have concerns about an enrolled participant, we will contact the parents and make an appropriate decision about the student's participation in the program.

YOA reserves the right to terminate, without a refund, the participation of any student whose medical history is found to have been falsified with regard to past treatment for physical, psychological, or emotional disorders.

ALTERATIONS TO ITINERARY

Our intention is to follow, as precisely as possible, the itineraries as described in our literature. Severe

weather, unusually high water, etc can necessitate an itinerary change. If an activity is deleted for any reason, it will be replaced with a comparable one. If the trip is cancelled for any reason prior to its start, YOA shall refund all tuition paid by the parent/guardian. If, during the course of the trip, it becomes necessary to terminate such trip, a portion of the unused tuition will be refunded.

FOOD

YOA meals are always plentiful and nutritious but reflect the limitations of our location and participants' preparation skills. Preparing group meals makes it impossible to provide separate meals for vegetarians, students with food allergies, vegans, or students with other eating restrictions. Vegetarians can expect to eat the same group meals, but can have the meat portion withheld. Students with food allergies should assess how their particular allergies might limit their meals. It is impossible for us to accommodate a vegan or kosher diet.
